

2023-2024 Uniform Dress Code-Grades K-8

UNIFORM SHIRTS/TOPS:

A. Daily Attire Options-Monday-Friday

- 1. Polo-style shirts must be either solid red, solid black or solid white and must have the HCS logo.
 - a. Shirts should be sized to fit, not oversized, nor snug fitting. Polos can be short or long-sleeved.
 - b. Long-sleeved solid white, red or black shirts may be worn under polos for warmth.

2. White button-up dress shirts or white button-up dress blouses

- a. These may be purchased at the retailer of your choice.
- b. White shirts should be worn under blouses or dress shirts for modesty purposes.
- c. No logo required on dress shirts or blouses.
- d. White is the only approved color.

B. Spirit-Wear Attire-**Fridays only** (unless otherwise indicated)

- 1. <u>T-shirts or hoodies</u> with Heritage "spirit wear" décor in red, black, white or gray (long or short-sleeved)
 - a. Spirit-Wear may be purchased locally at Beatty's or Hub Victor or online at <u>1stplacespiritwear.com</u>. (Search for Heritage Christian, Canton, OH)
 - b. Hoods cannot be worn over student's heads at any time at school.
 - c. Polo-style shirts with the HCS logo and white dress shirts may be worn on any day of the week.

UNIFORM PANTS, SHORTS, CAPRIS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS:

A. Daily Attire-Monday-Friday

- 1. **Pants**-uniform style, that are comparable to *IZOD, *Arizona, or *French Toast brands in **Khaki or Black**. Pants must be boot-cut, not skinny-cut.
 - a. These *brands are available at JCPenny, Kohl's, and GAP. Also check Amazon online.

- 2. **Shorts** in black or khaki, must be Bermuda style, no shorter than 2" from the top of the knee.
- 3. Capris, in black or khaki, that are modest in fit.
- 4. **Skirts or jumpers**, in black or khaki, any style, that are modest in fit and no shorter than 2" from the top of the knee.

Pants, shorts, capris and skirts must be secured at the waist, using a belt if appropriate; not sagging or falling down. No tears, frays or rips. These items should not be tight fitting nor of leather material.

NOT permitted at any time—Skinny-pant style, cargo pants, shorts or capris, nor athletic pants.

B. Spirit Wear-Fridays

- 1. Students may wear **jeans** if they donate \$1.00 which goes to the HCS general fundraising program.
 - a. Only boot-cut jeans are acceptable and must be clean, with no tears, frays or rips and contain no decorative wording.
 - b. Jean colors allowed are solid blue or solid black.
- 2. Jean **shorts** and jean **capris**, with the \$1.00 donation.
 - a. Allowable colors are solid blue or solid black. No shorter than 2" from the top of the knee.
- 3. Khaki or black uniform pants, shorts, skirts or jumpers may be worn for free.
- 4. NOT permitted at any time--Skinny-pant style, cargo pants, shorts or capris, and athletic style pants.

GENERAL DRESS CODE INFORMATION:

Shoes, Socks, Leggings, Tights—Athletic shoes, dress shoes, close-toed sandals or boots are acceptable in any color. No flip flops or high heels, nor over-the-knee boots. Crocs-like shoes may be worn with the strap secured at the heel. Socks, leggings and tights may be any color. Leggings may be worn under a skirt but are not permitted to be worn alone as uniform pants.

Winter Wear—During cold weather months, students may wear the following items in the classroom over uniform shirts: sweaters (v-neck, crew-neck, or cardigan styles), lightweight fleece or hoodies. <u>Acceptable colors are solid red, black or white</u>. No patterns or designs permitted with the exception of a brand logo that is no larger than baseball-size unless it is a Heritage hoodie. These items may be purchased at a retailer of your choice. Long sleeved solid white, red or black shirts may be worn under polos. Jackets and winter coats are NOT to be worn in the classroom.

Jewelry & Tattoos—No inappropriate jewelry or piercings or tattoos. If tattoos are deemed inappropriate for content or art the student will be asked to keep them covered at all times.

Hair—Hair must be neat and clean. No extreme or unnatural hair coloring or styles that could be a distraction to the school day, as determined by HCS administration. Hair must be out of the eyes for safety purposes, so as not to obstruct student vision. Hats and hoods are to be removed when entering the building.

No dress code list is exhaustive. The general rule is modesty and good discretion. If you are uncertain about any item, bring it to the school for clarification before wearing it. School administration has the authority to decide what is and is not appropriate. Guidelines may be adapted as the need arises. This modesty and discretion rule applies to all school events, inside and outside of the school, including sporting events. It would also include any fundraisers where students are participating in the community.
